NOMINATIONS FOR SENIOR LECTURER AND ADVANCED SENIOR LECTURER TITLE

NB: These Guidelines have changed as of March 27, 2024

Eligibility

For Senior Lecturer: <u>At least 6 years full time service</u> to the College in the rank of Lecturer For Advanced Senior Lecturer: At least 3 years full time service to the College as Senior Lecturer

The nomination package for Senior Lecturer/Advanced Senior Lecturer is separate from the annual reappointment package. Senior Lecturer/Advanced Senior lecturer nominations must be submitted *electronically to* <u>cas_facultyaffairs@stonybrook.edu</u> by May 31. The electronic nomination file must contain the following:

- 1) Nominee's Current CV
- 2) Tally of the votes by tenure/tenure-track faculty in the academic unit with a summarized reasoning behind negative votes and abstentions.
- 3) Statement of Teaching Philosophy. This statement should address:
 - Pedagogy and Course content
 - Student success
 - Student mentoring
 - Assessment strategies which encourage learning outcomes and student growth
- 4) Diversity Statement from the candidate: The statement should indicate how Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) is addressed either in the content of courses or in course procedures.
- 5) Service Statement: Service to the department and college in the form of committee membership, curricular innovations, administrative roles, or enhancement of student life on campus
- 6) Teaching evaluations for each course taught in the last 3 years, from students and peers
- 7) Two letters of recommendation from tenured/tenure-track faculty from the academic unit
- 8) Three letters of recommendation from current or former students
- 9) Letter from the department/program chair containing summary endorsement of the nomination

Nominations for Advanced Senior Lecturer must include all of the items above and also:

- 10) The Chair's letter should address whether the nominee has contributed to national or international professional and educational efforts outside of Stony Brook. Such activities may include:
 - Membership in professional committees, societies, or panels outside the university
 - Leadership of impactful collaborations or outreach with the local community
 - Mastery in the practice of teaching in the form of conference presentations, proceedings, or participation in national assessments of student outcomes
 - Information on the nominee's participation in DEI activities at a national or international level
