The program provides paid internships in areas like planning, technology, renewable energy, sustainable infrastructure, and the circular economy. Key goals include training the next generation of climate innovators and strengthening New York State's climate policies by developing a skilled workforce for partner agencies.

Internships span planning, technology, renewable energy, sustainable infrastructure, and the circular economy. Functional areas include clean energy development, environmental engineering, communication, conservation, and waste management. Other areas may include green finance, GIS, data analysis, AI, and education.

- Work on climate-focused projects with agencies across New York State.
- Develop skills in areas like clean energy, environmental engineering, communication, and conservation. Internships may also cover waste management, GIS, data analysis, and AI
- Work directly with experienced professionals at partnering agencies such as the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), the Department of Public Service (DPS), NYSERDA, the Office of General Services (OGS), the Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Development, and SUNY System Administration. Build a strong foundation for sustainability careers
- Actively participate in projects aimed at building a cleaner and more sustainable world, making a tangible difference in environmental and societal well-being

Internship Details

- Open to currently enrolled SUNY students. Individual internships may require a degree in a relevant field Some roles may need a valid driver's license
- All internships are paid with many offering \$18/hour for undergraduates and \$20/hour for graduates
- Hours vary, with some internships specifying 20 to 37.5 hours per week typically Monday to Friday with potential flexibility. Weekend and holiday work may be required for some park roles
