The Fall 2020 undergraduate bulletin reflects the revised Computer Engineering (CE) and Electrical Engineering (EE) programs. These changes **apply only to freshman students admitted to CE or EE in Fall 2020 or later.**

1) Which curriculum should I follow?

• Students admitted prior to Fall 2020:

Students continue to follow the same requirements in effect when first admitted to either major. Electrical Engineering students follow the general track by default but can select one of two specializations: Microelectronics or Telecommunications

• Students currently pursuing entry to CE or EE majors:

Current Stony Brook students pursuing admission to the CE or EE majors should follow the Fall 2019 curriculum if admitted by Fall 2020.

• Newly admitted freshman students in Fall 2020 or later:
