DR. N. S. RAMAMURTHY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Mattoo Center for India Studies invites applications from undergraduates for the Dr. N.S. Ramamurthy Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship honors Dr. N.S. Ramamurthy, who was a professor at the Stony Brook University School of Dental Medicine from 1974 to 2003, and a founding member of the Mattoo Center for India Studies.

ELIGIBILITY

- ❖ Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at Stony Brook University.
- ❖ Must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0.
- ❖ Applicant must be enrolled in or have completed one course in India Studies recognized by the Mattoo Center with a grade of B or better.
- ❖ Scholarship recipients must take at least one India Studies course in the academic year following the award.
- ❖ Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated financial need.
- ❖ Students participating in the New York State's Excelsior Scholarship are eligible only for non-tuition support.

AWARD AMOUNT

- ❖ \$1000 (paid directly into the student's account)

PROCEDURE

- ❖ Download and complete the application form from the Center for India Studies website: www.stonybrook.edu/india
- ❖ Attach a formal or informal transcript
- ❖ Attach a personal statement of interest or involvement in the study of India (maximum 300 words).
- ❖ Arrange for a letter of recommendation from a faculty member to be mailed directly to Ms. Frances Kelley at the Center or emailed as a PDF to frances.kelley@stonybrook.edu.

DEADLINE

- ❖ Completed application form with supporting materials must reach the Center for India Studies by **March 15, 2021**. Awards will be announced by mid-April.
