#### What skills do global employers and graduate schools want students to possess? (<u>NACE</u> & <u>MWA</u>)

- <u>Interpersonal Skills:</u> Service orientation, social skills, teamwork, oral communication
- <u>Intrapersonal Skills</u>: Adaptability, capacity for improvement, ethical responsibility to self & others
- <u>Global Competency</u> : cultural self-awareness, cross-cultural awareness and adaptability, professionalism, leadership
- <u>Technology Skills</u>: Software knowledge, Microsoft Word and Google application

#### How can faculty and staff partner with the Career Center?
