The Mariposa Award 2024 Undergrad Award

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCT. 13

The Mariposa Undergraduate Education Award is a **\$500-\$1,000** award for books and other educational materials given to 2 SBU undergrads of undocumented status (or otherwise precarious immigration status) that makes them ineligible for many US scholarships. Major/minor concentration is open. Because of tax and confidentiality complications, the student will not receive the award money directly, but LACS will ask the recipient/s for a "wishlist" and purchase the books and educational materials for them. The money will be banked and usable through the end of the 2024-25 academic year.

Requirements

- Unofficial undergrad transcript
- 2-pg essay describing your accomplishments and personal background, your academic interests, and the specific educational materials that would aid your coursework, research, and intellectual progress for the remainder of this academic year (books, small tech or equipment for classes, materials for poster presentations, grad school application fees, etc).
- Current resume/CV
- ONE letter of recommendation from an SBU faculty member (faculty members should send their confidential letters directly to <u>lacs@stonybrook.edu</u>)
