Obtain Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) License To register as a new researcher, the DEA Form 225 must be completed. If you conducts research at more than one location, each place must be separately registered with the DEA.

The DEA Form 225 should be completed online. A paper version of the

Fill in the application with THE EXACT SAME INFORMATION as shown on your BNE license (name, address, etc.)

NOTE: Schedule II-V researchers are not required to submit a research protocol with the application. Only schedule I applicants must submit a protocol.

On the next page, check off the box that says CERTIFICATION FOR FEE EXEMPTION - Government Only, then provide the following details:

Select the drug schedules you plan to use (both narcotic and non-narcotic). Only select Schedule II if you have a safe!

Fill in your State License information (BNE License), follow the prompts (Schedule II users will need to select the drugs they plan to use), and then submit.

Once your DEA application is reviewed, the DEA will contact you to set up an **in-person inspection** of your lock box/safe (This is separate from the BNE inspection). Keep the Certificate of Registration (DEA Form 223) at the registered location in a readily retrievable manner and available for official inspection. If you need a duplicate Certificate of Registration, a copy can be requested online, or by contacting DEA Headquarters at 1-800-882-9539, or via e-mail at DEA.Registration.Help@dea.gov

If you are using Schedule II drugs, you will also need DEA 222 forms for purchasing them.

You must renew your DEA license every year.
