Below are discussion notes on the basis of which the Committee voted.</li> <li>There is no evidence in the assignment projects and assessment plans, as described in the syllabus provided to us, that the requested SBCs are justified.</li> <li>It is not enough to list the SBC objectives: the course syllabus must substantially demonstrate that the requested SBCs' student learning outcomes are met substantially. In fact, listing more than the required (or intended) number of SBC objectives can backfire in terms of the provided syllabus's ability to show that what is promised is carried out. Reviewers expect all listed objectives to be met by course content, student work, and instructor assessment.</li> <li>The larger point of discussion raised by this request was about the curricular review principles that members of the committee follow, which seem worth relaying here: curricular review requires Committee members to demand evidence in the course syllabus. We are unable to judge from course content the learning outcomes of a course. 		you that we have completed the curricular review of your proposal for BA in Communication, including all the new courses within the new degree program. Thank you for quickly submitting missing information in the initial submission.
		I write this email to relay Committee approval for the degree proposal. As we requested you to submit each course separately (which helps us to track the collaborative review process and record and report the decisions), I will follow up with separate decisions and feedback (where applicable) for each of the courses.
		The Committee didn't reject the proposal for any course, voted to request that a few courses be revised (because there were major issues), approved others with feedback on minor issues, and approved the rest without issue.
		Please note that reviewers propose revision requests when there are major issues. With minor issues, they may choose not to comment, which is why you may notice inconsistencies in feedback on minor issues across the syllabi. Distinct from that review, our in-house CELT consultant was requested to provide
		supplemental feedback on some of the syllabi that seemed to require special attention (because, for instance, they used non-standard curricular objective language or didn't seem to demonstrate how the assignments and assessments would help achieve the learning goals). This expert also provided a general
		checklist compiling feedback from multiple courses, to which I further added minor feedback from all the other reviewers. I will link <u>that checklist</u> in my email about all courses; all of the instructors might want to check off their courses against the checklist, as doing so might reduce the number of issues at the next stage of the review/approval.
