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	On behalf of the Arts & Sciences Curriculum Committee, I am writing to inform you that your proposal for new course AAS/KOR 2xx (Korean Literature) was voted as "revise and resubmit."
	 The committee made the following revision recommendations: Identify course-specific outcomes and align them more explicitly with the assessment plans when revising the syllabus. Use the up-to-date institutional policy statements (linked here). Provide a more detailed description of the "attendance and participation" portion of the grading to explain more concretely how participation will be assessed; Add more information about the Co-generating Dialogue assignment; it is not clear that this is a group project/presentation until the end of the description. Suggested: Meet with Assessment Specialist in CELT for assistance in developing rubrics. Add ISBN numbers for required text to make it easy for students to locate. One effective strategy used by instructors to save time when developing new courses, or when there are many or major issues to revise, is to adapt <u>the CELT template</u> (which we don't require but recommend) to fit their needs.
	We encourage faculty colleagues preparing the course material and proposal to use the relevant checklist <u>here</u> for ensuring that the revision meets the criteria by which we have reviewed (and will review) the proposal.
