Abstract

Summary of some issues discussed recently at Senate Executive Committee meetings and various other issues for February 2013 A&S Senate meeting.

1. General Education Curriculum The University Senate accepted the broad outlines of the revised Stony Brook General Education Curriculum committee report at its December meeting, but asked for some revisions concerning the inclusion of a Technology requirement and also deferred decisions on minimum grade requirements, revisions to permit the new curriculum to mesh with Health Sciences requirements and existing Stony Brook course structures. 2. Provost's Outstanding Lecturers 2013
