## Graduate Council Report for the 2023/2024 academic year (see also minutes)

**Charge**: It is the mandate of the Graduate Council to "advise the Dean of the Graduate School and monitor all aspects of the University's graduate program. It will evaluate all proposed new graduate programs and degrees and will participate in program review of existing graduate programs." "New graduate programs and changes to existing programs must be approved by the Graduate Council, SUNY Central in Albany and registered with the State Education Department (SED). Proposals that have resource implications (e.g., need for new faculty) will also need approval of the appropriate College Dean before Graduate Council consideration." The Graduate Council also has a Graduate Council Appeals Committee (GCAC), which when requested by the Dean of the Graduate School, reviews documents and makes recommendations related to student appeals of program decisions. The committee comprises two faculty members appointed by the Graduate Council and two students appointed by the GSO. A third faculty member serves as an alternate.

**Membership**: The Graduate Council includes two representatives from the Humanities and Fine Arts, two from Social and Behavioral Sciences, two from Natural Sciences, one from the Library, two from the College of Engineering, one from the College of Business, two from the Health Science Center, one professional, two graduate students from the GSO. Also participating are nonvoting members from the Graduate School and Provost's office, the registrar and one volunteer faculty. (See separate Table)

**Council 23/24 functions:** During the 2023/2024 academic year the Graduate Council met eleven times and there was one appeal. As listed below, the Council evaluated seven new programs, seven revisions to existing programs, five reaffirmations and one disaggregation. In addition, the Council reviewed various policy updates related to English language requirements, degree requirements, dissertation committees, tuition scholarships, course and credit enrollment, credit for 700/800 courses, bulletin updates and a draft of a Stony Brook Graduate School mentoring contract.
