- Pat shared her SPD history and evolution.
- She intends to be transparent with the Faculty Senate and share SPD data with the Council.
- SPD Advisory Boards created; D-TALE, Human Services and HEA
- Imminent new hire, Executive Director of Educational Programs and Curriculum
- Some new initiatives:

- 1. Pat will designate someone to work with Teacher Centers to evaluate needs SPD can fill.
- 2. An HRM Advanced Graduate Certificate is currently in approval stages at SUNY.
- 3. SPD is applying for NYS funding for Human Services non-credit programs
- 4. With support from the Provost, SPD is developing a pilot program, Digital Launchpad, to work with CELT, an outside source (Wiley) and faculty to develop new programs.
- 5. SPD is developing a Masters in Human Services.
- Micro-credentials: Pat suggested there needs to be a governance in faculty review of curriculum regarding campus-wide micro-credentials. Pat attended a recent meeting and a campus policy was created; it needs to be approved by SBU and then by SUNY.
- Pat requested assistance from Nancy for East Campus representation on the SPD Council.
