 - benchmark satisfaction of Critical Reasoning to a subset of the SBC requirements.

2. Academic Judiciary Review Update

- Katherine Johnston from English/Writing and Rhetoric agreed to represent the UGC on this committee.

3. Admissions policy review

HN led a discussion on what role the UGC should play in admissions policy review and scholarship criteria review

The following were noted:

- this is part of the UGC charge and the UGC agreed to retain it, yet the UGC has not reviewed this in recent memory
- with the new changes in legal landscape, it is important that the admission and scholarship process be well documented and transparent.
- The UGC remains unclear as to how extensive a role it should play but agreed that we would start a long-term fact-finding effort that can be interrupted for more time-sensitive issues.
