This was put to a local vote to all SUNY and passed by 87%.
- The International Student Fee is now in the process of being phased out at the statewide level.
- GSU did win an increase in the base salary of graduate students in last spring. We are still well below that lowest poverty mark so GSU will continue the living wage campaign.
- We will bargain over stipends, health care, international worker protections, and many other things including parking.
